- The Swede sat in the first seat on the left.
- The person who did a pub quiz sat next to the person who ate steak.
- The person who sang a song sat next to the person who ate the vegetarian dinner.
- The whisky drinker did a crossword.
- The French person did a magic trick.
- The Swede sat next to the physicist.
